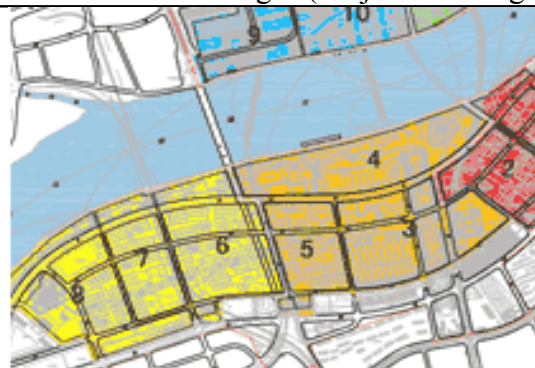

Shanghai World Expo Site

The Expo Site covers a total area of 5.28 square kilometers, including the enclosed area and outside areas of support facilities. The Expo Site spans both sides of the Huangpu River, with 3.93 sq km in Pudong and 1.35 sq km in Puxi. The enclosed area measures 3.28 sq km. There are 12 pavilion groups, eight in the Pudong Section and four in Puxi, each with an average area of 10–15 hectares.

ITINERARY

9 DAYS/8 NIGHTS SHANGHAI & WORLD EXPO

- Day 1 Saturday :** 6.30AM depart Canberra; 7.00PM arrival in Shanghai, meet and transfer to hotel to check in. Dinner and briefing talk/welcome and early night
Hotel
- Day 2 Sunday :** Lupu Cross River Bridge – the second biggest of it's type in the world. Climb to the top where visitors can see the whole of Shanghai and the World Expo site.
Bus into Shanghai World Expo – Lunch at Expo
Dinner and drinks at Yu Yuan Brazil
- Day 3 Monday :** Shanghai World Expo all day – lunch at Expo
Evening - Walk and dinner on Heng Shan Rd
- Day 4 Tuesday :** Morning - Shanghai World Expo 9.00
Lunchtime bus to Yuyuan Garden: Located at a very busy marketplace in a complex of traditional-style buildings, backing onto Yu Gardens. See a small (reconstructed) Temple (Chenghuang: Temple of the City Gods).
Lunch at Xiao Nan Guo Restaurant.
Walk down Nanjing Rd to “The Bund”. Once the home of the foreign traders and major banks, the embankment has taken on a new vitality; lovely old European-style buildings mix with futuristic developments, chic restaurants, top end shops and bars offer plenty to see and do – and by night it's magic!
Xin Tian Di for dinner at Brazil and drinks. Xin Tian Di is the rejuvenated old quarter, with lots of cafes, quirky and up-market shops, western food and close to the major hotels. After stroll through Xin Tian Di bars
- Day 5 Wednesday :** Morning – Shanghai World Expo
Local Shanghai Restaurant for Lunch
After lunch business meetings, rest or shopping
Dinner Pauliner Beer Hall
- Day 6 Thursday :** Visit the “The Pearl of the Oriental” TV Tower. POF is the biggest tower in Asia and the third largest one in the world with its fantastic design.
Xiao Nan Guo Restaurant Peking Duck restaurant and experience the traditional preparation of this famous meal.
After lunch visit observation deck of Jin Mao Tower (Shanghai World Financial Center). The Shanghai World Financial Center is a super tall skyscraper.
Traditional Sichuan restaurant dinner
- Day 7 Friday :** Air-conditioned bus to Zhouzhuang Water Town which is an ancient culture town to the west of Shanghai. An ancient water town on an island in a lake in the ‘land of rice and fish’. Visitors may explore picturesque narrow canals, little streets, bridges and overhanging traditional houses, visit well-preserved old residences with good displays, eat delicious fish or other local delicacies and enjoy the balladeers in the waterside teahouses.
